Whether walking in public or on private property, all dog owners should be familiar with all laws, bylaws and regulations pertaining to their dogs, including the <u>National Capital Commission Domestic Animal Regulations</u>, the <u>Ottawa's Animal Care and Control Bylaws</u> and <u>Ontario's Dog Owner Liability Act (2005)</u>. Owners of dogs that are restricted under the Provincial Dog Owners' Liability Act should also be familiar with the new Pit Bull Controls.

Dog owners have a legal and moral obligation to keep their dogs under control at **all times** for the safety of the public, other animals, and their own dogs.
